
***Feast of the Presentation of the Lord -  
 "Candlemas"***

***Candles will be blessed at both Masses  
 on Monday, February 2nd  
 (Candles are available for purchase

The feast was first observed in the Eastern Church as "The Encounter." In the sixth century it began to be observed in the West: in Rome with a more penitential character and in Gaul (France) with solemn blessings and processions of candles, popularly known as "Candlemas."

The presentation of the Lord concludes the celebration of the Nativity and with the offerings of the Virgin Mother and the prophecy of Simeon, the events now point toward Easter. Christ is the light of the nations, hence the blessing and procession of candles on this day (www.catholicculture.org).
